

DEPARTMENT OF DRAMA UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST

Please refer to Syracuse University's application instructions for more detailed information on the application requirements. Don't forget our deadlines:

Early Decision

November 1: Application and audition, design portfolio review, or interview must be completed.

Regular Decision

January 1: Application postmarked deadline.

January 15: Audition or design portfolio review must be postmarked if submitted by mail.

February 1: In-person audition, design portfolio review, or interview must be completed. Financial aid forms are due.

Department of Drama Application Requirements

- Audition, portfolio review, or other materials specific to your desired major
- A current resume listing all productions in which you have been involved (and when and where produced)
- A brief statement describing why you are choosing a career in your specific area of the theater
- Applicants to acting and musical theater must also submit a photograph (this does not have to be a professional head shot)
- Applicants to theater design and technology and stage management must also submit letters of reference from directors, theater teachers, or technical directors with whom they have worked

Syracuse University Application Requirements

- \$70 application fee (check or money order)
- Personal essay between 250 and 500 words (approximately one page)
- Secondary school counselor evaluation
- Two academic recommendation forms
- Official high school transcript
- SAT or ACT scores
- TOEFL scores for applicants whose native language is not English
- School profile (sent by guidance counselor)
- If submitting the Common Application, include the Common Application Supplement Important Application Information form. All questions must be answered and this page must be signed.
- Early Decision Commitment Contract (for Early Decision applicants only)
- Senior Grade Report (request that your guidance counselor submit this)
- Non-U.S. citizenship form if required
- Non-U.S. citizens should provide required information on citizenship, financial support, and sponsorship
