Early Decision

November 1: Application and audition must be completed.

Regular Decision

January 1: Application postmarked deadline.

January 15: Audition must be postmarked if submitted by mail.

February 1: In-person auditions must be completed. Financial aid forms are due.

Setnor School of Music Application Requirements

Audition

Typed resume (two copies if you are auditioning on two instruments) listing:

- Your full name (including middle name)
- Address
- Phone number
- E-mail address
- Primary instrument
- Intended major
- First-year or transfer status
- Previous music study in school as well as private music study. Include the name of your teachers or classes and the length of time studied. Also bring a selected list of works studied (solo repertoire included), where and when they were performed, method books, etudes, etc.
- Voice students should also list any roles or solos in musical theater or featured solos in a choral setting.
- Composition students (both first-year students and transfers) are also required to submit several representative written original compositions in addition to the audition.

Syracuse University Application Requirements

\$70 application fee (check or money order)

Personal essay between 250 and 500 words (approximately one page)

Secondary school counselor evaluation

Two academic recommendation forms

Official high school transcript

SAT or ACT scores

TOEFL scores for applicants whose native language is not English

School profile (sent by guidance counselor)

If submitting the Common Application, include the Common Application Supplement Important Application Information form. All questions must be answered and this page must be signed.

Early Decision Commitment Contract (for Early Decision applicants only)

Senior Grade Report (request that your guidance counselor submit this)

Non-U.S. citizenship form if required

Non-U.S. citizens should provide required information on citizenship, financial support, and sponsorship
